



## An Outline of the Restorative Justice Program

The Restorative Justice Program is conducted in a group setting. Residents of the prison and volunteers from the community meet weekly for 10-12 weeks for two hours.

The heart of the program is an intensive three-day experience. Each of these days lasts four hours. On the second day two victim-survivors share their stories.
